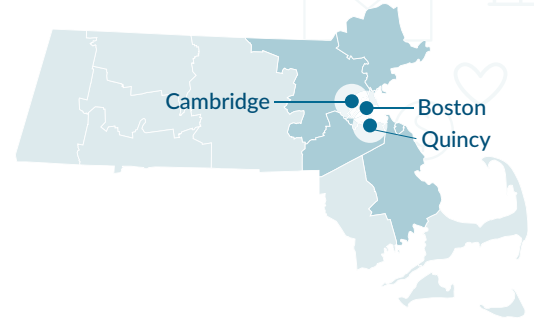


BOSTON-CAMBRIDGE-QUINCY METRO AREA
